Starting next Friday, 15 May 2020, the KunstFestSpiele Herrenhausen will present selected artists from the 2020 Festival programme online in various formats over a period of two weeks. On Thursday, 14 May, artistic director Ingo Metzmacher, Lord Mayor Belit Onay and participating artists will also present the detailed stage programme for autumn 2020. The KunstFestSpiele were to have begun tomorrow evening with the laser and sound installation Fountain Scan by Robert Henke to mark the 300th anniversary of the Great Fountain in the Great Garden of Herrenhausen, but were cancelled at the beginning of March due to the coronavirus pandemic. The festival, which has been moved to the autumn, will take place from 24 September to 11 October 2020, subject to further reservations.

A highlight of the online programme in May is the virtual version of Vlatka Horvat's reading performance <u>Beginnings</u> <u>Marathon</u> on 17 May, which she is reformulating for digital space for the first time. The audience is invited online to read the first page of their favourite book. The participatory performance stages the act of reading aloud and creates a special community of readers and listeners.

Ingo Metzmacher, Artistic Director of KunstFestSpiele Herrenhausen: "Our online programme in May throws light on the work of some of the invited artists who will be performing on our stages from 24 September. It will be informative, musical, culinary and communal. It is, of course, not an equivalent substitute for the live performances of the KunstFestSpiele. The experience in the space with all the spectators together and the immediate experience of sound and bodies cannot be translated into the digital. But in the past weeks we have seen the potential of the digital. Only through the experiences of artists and participants can quality and diversity develop here as well. So I myself am very excited about our excursion into the digital space. We'll see each other again soon, e.g. at the virtual Beginnings Marathon, and hopefully again in the natural surroundings of the Herrenhausen Gardens at the end of September."
